1	Rule 3	Application for Factory Registration / Construction	Applications were required <b>in physical Form 1</b> , with copies in duplicate.	Applications to be submitted <b>electronically in Form 1</b> . Duplicate copies deleted.
2	Rule 3-A	Certificate of Stability	Required approval and explanation from Inspector; manual process.	<b>Approval clause deleted.</b> Certificate of stability (Form 1A) to be submitted <b>within</b> 12 months of license issue.
3	Rule 5	Licensing Fees	License fee structure last updated in <b>2013</b> .	Fee structure revised <b>for 2026</b> .  New <b>Schedule A &amp; B</b> introduced for non-power and power-generating factories.
4	Rule 6	Issue of License	License issued in <b>Form 4</b> (physical).	License to be issued <b>electronically in Form 4</b> .
5	Rule 8	Renewal of License	Manual renewal of license.	Renewal to be done <b>electronically in Form 4</b> .
6	Rule 11	Miscellaneous (Redundant)	Contained redundant provisions.	Deleted.
7	Rule 14	Notice of Occupation	Manual submission of "Notice of Occupation."	To be submitted <b>electronically in Form</b> 1 with supporting documents. License also issued online.
8	Rule 15	Amendment / Change of Manager	Used <b>Form 5</b> for amendment or manager change notice.	Form 5 deleted; amendment/change to be done through Form 1 electronically.
9	Rule 18-A	Medical Examination of Workers	Limited to hazardous factories only.	<b>Annual medical exam mandatory</b> for all workers above 45 years, free of cost via <b>Form 7-A (online)</b> within 15 days.
10	New Rule 73-ZD	Mock Drill	No prior requirement for mock drills.	<b>Mandatory mock drills</b> every 6 months; report date and scenario to Inspector within 15 days.
11	Rule 73-W	Qualification of Medical Officers	Applied to smaller workforce (50–200 workers).  And Certifying surgeons approved by Government.	Thresholds revised: now <b>150– 500</b> workers; and experience requirement of <b>3 years</b> for industrial medical examiners.
12	Rule 79	Safety Committees / Procedures	Contained a proviso clause.	Proviso deleted.



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13	Rule 102-B	Employment of Women (Night Shifts)	Women's employment at night was restricted or required prior permission.	Night work (7 p.m6 a.m.) allowed with safeguards: transport, lighting, CCTV, consent, minimum two women on shift, grievance meetings.
14	Rule 102-C	Miscellaneous (Deleted)	Separate provisions for women's work.	Deleted.
15	Rule 114	Protection for Women	Referred only to "women."	Substituted with "pregnant women and lactating mothers" across schedules.
16	Rule 114-A	Safety for Women in Dangerous Operations	General provisions for women in hazardous operations.	<b>Detailed safety measures</b> added — PPE, respirators, training, restriction on exposure to harmful substances.
17	Form 1	Application Form	Separate paper forms for application, occupation, renewal, amendment.	<b>Unified digital Form 1</b> for all purposes: registration, renewal, amendment, notice.
18	Form 4	Factory License	Physical license issued manually.	Electronic Factory License introduced.
19	Form 5	Amendment Form	Amendment form.	<b>Deleted</b> ; replaced by electronic Form 1.
20	New Form 7-A	Health Register	Not applicable earlier.	Introduced for Health Register in Form 7-A for online record of medical examinations (for non-hazardous workers).
